

Sir, EXSUM below describes the major outcomes of Army Profession and Leader Development Forum held 22 Aug 17.

(U) ARMY PROFESSION AND LEADER DEVELOPMENT FORUM (APLDF) 17-4. Provided for information to CG, TRADOC. On 22 Aug 17, LTG Lundy, CG CAC, hosted APLDF 17-4. Senior attendee was Ms. Diane Randon, SES, Senior Official Performing the Duties of the ASA, M&RA. This forum had a multi-cohort and multi-component focus with outcomes that included of review of Commander 360 compliance, USACC's Cadre and Faculty Development Course resourcing, and progress of AU's Mid-Grade Learning Continuum initiative. Updates were provided on the potential for establishing a Probationary Supervisor 360; development of an In Person Supervisor Development Course; mandating CES for Supervisors; the current status of CES Requirements, Selection and Resourcing; and potential for implementing Leader Track for civilians. Topics for decision included Civilian Education System requirements development way ahead; Supervisory Development Course way ahead; Character Development way ahead; and approval of the FY18 ALDP Priority List. Information briefs were provided on the selection process and study focus areas for FY 18 Strategic Broadening Seminars; the NCO PME Common Core Competencies initiative; and USARC's USAR Leader Development program. CAL will forward an Outcomes and Taskers Memorandum to key stakeholders to maintain momentum within the ALDP and drive actions to improve leader readiness. Due outs and taskers will be reviewed at the next APLDF 18-1 on 15 Nov 17.
